2) AIDS Awareness

Importance:

Requirement of AIDS Awareness: The age group of 15-29 years among the youth is considered to be more susceptible to HIV / AIDS infection. Mental and social status at this age creates a curiosity about sexuality as it is sensitive. In addition, lack of proper information about HIV / AIDS and limited ability to acquire life skills increase the risk of infection.

AIDS Awareness encourages young people to lead a safe and healthy lifestyle. The Red Ribbon Club encourages and directs young people to learn about HIV / AIDS, as well as to encourage safe sex and voluntary blood donation.

The Red Ribbon Club enables college youth to contribute to the HIV program by creating awareness about HIV / AIDS.

Aims and Objectives -

1) To give energy / strength to the youth by giving them proper information about HIV / AIDS prevention, care and support treatment.

2) Empowering youth to spread the message of positive health behaviors in a healthy environment

7. Organizing the Red Ribbon Club and planning to increase the participation of college youth in HIV / AIDS awareness programs and activities so that their energy is rewarded for the right work.

8. To create youth peer educators in the college as well as outside youth as well as to create awareness through Red Ribbon Club under the guidance of sensitization lecturers.

The Practice :
