- > To develop research interest, awareness and aptitude among researchers.
- > To provide infrastructure and learning resources to carry out research.
- Effective implementation of research strategy at various levels.
- Making maximum efforts to enhance research capacity.
- Making research community oriented.
- To promote aspects of research through various projects.

3. The Context:

To create maximum research attitude among students and professors.

According to the policy of University of Mumbai to give projects to students.

To promote research knowledge and its fundamentals through various strategies.

Effective and successful implementation of the 'Research Policy' as per the guidelines of the University.

Financial assistance is provided to researchers in the form of fellowships through various (Sarthi, Barti, MahaJyoti) organizations.

4. The Practice - procedure

Our college fosters and promotes various aspects of research. There is a suitable environment for students and professors.

At the beginning of the academic year the 'Research Committee' convenes a meeting and formulates a plan of action and implements it. Notification is displayed for new admission for History Ph. D. with interviews in history. Selection is made for admission.

The 'Research Advisory Committee' approves the research Design/ Synopsis of the research students. Later these proposals are sent to Mumbai University for registration.

Projects are given to students for U.G. & P.G. Experts in relevant fields are invited. Students are given seminars on research.

Through SARTHI, BARTI AND MAHAJYOTI, our research students are guided for various fellowships for research. Among them SARTHI, BARTI Maharashtra government fellowships have been approved for our research students.

5. Evidence of success

Two researchers have been awarded Ph. D. degrees from the Ph. D. History Research Center of our college and M.A. students have presented their 100 mark and 40-mark projects very well. Students of T.Y.B.A. and T.Y.B.SC. have submitted projects for graduation. Students of F.Y.B.A., B. Com. and B.Sc. Foundation courses present projects on this subject every year.

Our college professors' Ph. D. the rate of occurrence is high. They publish his research papers in U.G.C. Care List Journal and International Peer Review Journal every year. Dr. Baban Jadhav of our college has received Mumbai University's Best Teacher Award for his good research performance. He has also received the Best Head of Department Award, History Researcher Award and Dnanbhushan Award.

5. Evidence of Success:

The best practice of cultivating the qualities of Freedom, Patriotism, National Integration was successfully implemented. In this two days public cleanliness campaign was successfully carried out at Joint Director Office (Higher Education), Panvel by removing the grass and picking up the waste material, the work was around ten thousand rupees. Similarly, awareness about cleanliness and social work was created among the students. Keeping in mind the importance of the Indian tricolor, 'Har Ghar Tiranga' campaign was successful due to the awareness raised by the Deputy Commissioner, Panvel Municipal Corporation about hoisting the tricolor at every house. 50 trees were planted in Kalamboli. Awareness and superstition was eradicated by giving 110 sanitary pads to the female students of the college. Through various competitions, awareness about Indian Freedom, Patriotism, National Integration, social issues were realized among the students. Just as the students hoisted the tricolor at their own homes, Kalamboli took out rallies in the towns and created a lot of awareness to hoist the tricolor among the people as well. The students understood the history through the lectures about the struggle of the Indian freedom movement and the participation of tribals in the freedom movement. In this way the twelve days program was very excellent.







3. The Context:

S.M.D.L. College Kalamoboli always had sustainable initiatives at the core of all activities, despite the relatively small campus 650 students, 30 + faculty at various levels. S.M.D.L College campus has significant greenery covering all parts of the campus, something that is appreciated by all visitors on campus. As College is located semi urban shadow region. It was necessary to look forward to make efficient use of available water and other resources. A clean and healthy environment aids effective learning and provides a conductive learning environment. We decided to educate and make aware students on the issues such as renewable energy sources, waste management and recycling. We decided to work in the areas of power, plant, water and cleanliness. The stakeholders work to develop an eco-friendly, sustainable campus and to disseminate the concept of eco-friendly culture.

4. The Practice:

The institution has a system for green-auditing of its facilities which is carried out informally by the National Service Scheme. The use of plastic bags is avoided in the campus and the authority planning to declare the entire campus as "No Plastic Zone". Students and

staff are motivated to use jute bags or cotton bags. The students and staff have planted several tree saplings during various tree plantation programmes organized by the institution through the NSS unit and all these plants are taken care of and maintained by the college of the institution. Care is taken to ensure that the college environment has low levels of carbon emission and low pollution levels so that the campus is healthy for all. The college is declared as 'No Tobacco Zone'.

Faculty and students led initiatives to save significant electricity by conducting awareness programmes on energy conservation and adopts measures to ensure that energy is conserved wherever possible. Every department follows

a policy of switching on power only when required and switching off when not in use.

Plantation of trees and green grass in the college quadrangle and in the front end. Potted plants dot the corridors of the college with more than 40 different samples.

Tree plantation drives are organized regularly to create clean and green campus. The NSS unit of the college take up planting saplings regularly. The Botany department of the college maintains a large variety of medicinal plants and wide variety of plant species. Planting of tree saplings by chief guests during their visits to the college for various functions.

On rainy days, rain water falling on the roof of the college is properly brought to the ground through pipes. The required amount of water is given to the flowers and various plants next to the college.

The use of plastic bags is banned in colleges. In addition, the use of plastic bags through the NSS is always a public awareness.

Ornamental flowers have been planted in the college premises. Also, various trees have been planted near the playground of Sudhagad Education Society. NSS volunteers are working to save them.

Solid waste management for collecting the solid waste from nook and corner of the campus substantial number of dustbins are installed.

Sewage from bathrooms and toilets is connected to the municipal drainage system. It doesn't leak anywhere. Liquid waste All the liquid waste from washroom, bathroom is collected into soakage pits through systematic drainage. Zero percent leakage of waste water is ensured.

The programme with external agencies should be organized to let people of the area understand the importance of environment cleanliness and up gradation.

Maintaining the motivation level in voluntary work and ensuring the wholehearted involvement of volunteers in all the activities was also a problem which requires careful teacher supervision.

Use of paper cups and plates is encouraged and the use of plastic bags and plastic tea cups is banned. Plastic free culture is imbibed.



Most of them have very moderate educational background. W.D.C. had to hard work for convincing girl's student to speak out their problems. These girl students are not aware about their legal rights due to poor financial condition and illiterate family. WDC as a create more awareness among the parents and students. There is a need for more awareness among the parents about health and protection issues of their girl child.

There is also a great need to create awareness about gender sensitivity and equality among both girls and boy's students of the institution.
